

## **Risk Assessment Guidance**

These guidelines will help you prepare for your visit to Chatsworth and to ensure that you and your group have a safe and enjoyable learning experience when you are here.

It is your responsibility to carry out a site-specific risk assessment in advance of your visit. Please contact the Bookings team to arrange a free pre-visit to prepare your risk assessment <u>visit@chatsworth.org</u>

## It is advisable to take the following into account when preparing your risk assessment:

- Education Authority guidelines concerning the correct pupil/staff supervision ratio must be adhered to.
- Group leaders take full responsibility for the conduct of the group and for supervising those in their care.
- In the unlikely event that the behaviour of the group is considered to present a risk to the group or to any other visitor/s, Chatsworth staff will discreetly intervene.
